CLIMATE SOLUTIONS PRIZE

proposes to galvanize Israel, also known as the Start-Up Nation, to curb the climate crisis. It aims to support and inspire increased research and development for breakthrough climate solutions by awarding the best and the brightest not-for-profit researchers and/or organizations throughout Israel with the prize's funding and recognition.

The prize of \$1-Million USD will be granted to a maximum of four (4) researchers, annually, in recognition of their work on promising solutions to our climate crisis. Proposals will be evaluated by a world-class judging panel and the recipient will be announced during a live competition in Israel which will be broadcast, worldwide.

Notably, the Climate Solutions Prize also aims to inspire younger generations in Israel and worldwide to be a source of solutions, having the power to help repair the world (Tikkun Olam).

THE

CLIMATE SOLUTIONS PRIZE QUEBEC INITIATIVE

will offer additional prizes in the amount of \$100,000 CAD to local Quebec talents towards solving the climate crisis.

Researchers, not-for-profit, NGO's, incubators, and students across Quebec will be given the opportunity to compete for the local prize and help bring Quebec to the forefront of the battle against the climate crisis.

Quebec is home to some of the world's top universities and the Climate Solutions Prize aims to bring the brightest minds in Quebec to the world stage in solving climate change.

Montreal is now known as one of Canada's premier technology hubs and in fact ranks highly across North America. In 1990, before Google became so common it turned into a verb, a group of three McGill University computer science students created a searchable database they called Archie. Archie was the first of its kind, and paved the way for the many web search engines we're so familiar with today.

Montreal is currently the third largest producer of video games in the world with major companies like Ubisoft, Eidos Interactive, EA, Strategy First, and many more. Montreal is also becoming a popular location for tech start-ups that are creating cutting-edge technologies and software advancements. Part of the reason for all this digital growth is that the city and the province of Quebec are investing in these industries, so they're likely to keep getting bigger!

SPACEIL

DID YOU KNOW?

SpaceIL, an Israeli organization, competed in the Google Lunar X
Prize contest to land a spacecraft on the Moon. SpaceIL successfully launched its Beresheet lander on February 22 2019.

Although Beresheet encountered technical issues and crashed on the lunar surface, this accomplishment made Israel the 4th country, after the Soviet Union, the United States, and China to attempt a soft landing on the Moon. Israel was awarded a \$1 million "Moonshot" Award by the X Prize Foundation in recognition of touching the surface of the Moon.

Why A Prize?

Many prizes have resulted in major impact developments in the world of science and have helped change the world. From the British Government Prize offered for finding the longitude lines of the world to Northcliffe's most ambitious prize for the first Transatlantic voyage, prizes have motivated the scientific and engineering communities to find solutions beyond the knowledge already known.

The Climate Solutions Prize plans to take this approach and harness the brightest minds to help stop the climate crisis.

MAY HOLD THE ANSWER


Global rankings of the top innovation ecosystems in the world consistently find Israel to be one of the world's top locations for entrepreneurs and venture capitalists.

Israel's innovative journey was shaped by the first collective communities, or the 'Kibbutzim', with immigrants from over 130 nations experimenting with new agricultural methods and social structures. Developing a knack for innovating and risk-taking, Israelis soon ventured into other sectors, contributing their knowledge and skills to create Israel's first industries. Israel's top educational institutions have cultivated a knowledgeable nation of scientists, engineers, doctors and professors that strive to lead research trends in their fields.

As a result, Israel has a notably high concentration of Nobel Prize laureates in comparison to its relatively small population.

Israel has made efforts to attract international technological companies to the wealth of engineering talent in the country, prompting major multinational companies like IBM, Intel, Motorola and Philips to establish research and development centres in the country. Not only is Israel's engineering and entrepreneurial talent among the brightest in the world, it is also one of the most creative and diverse.

From impressive progress in computing technology, to efficient agritech solutions and life-saving medical feats, Israel's list of contributions to human innovation is protracted when considering its small size.
